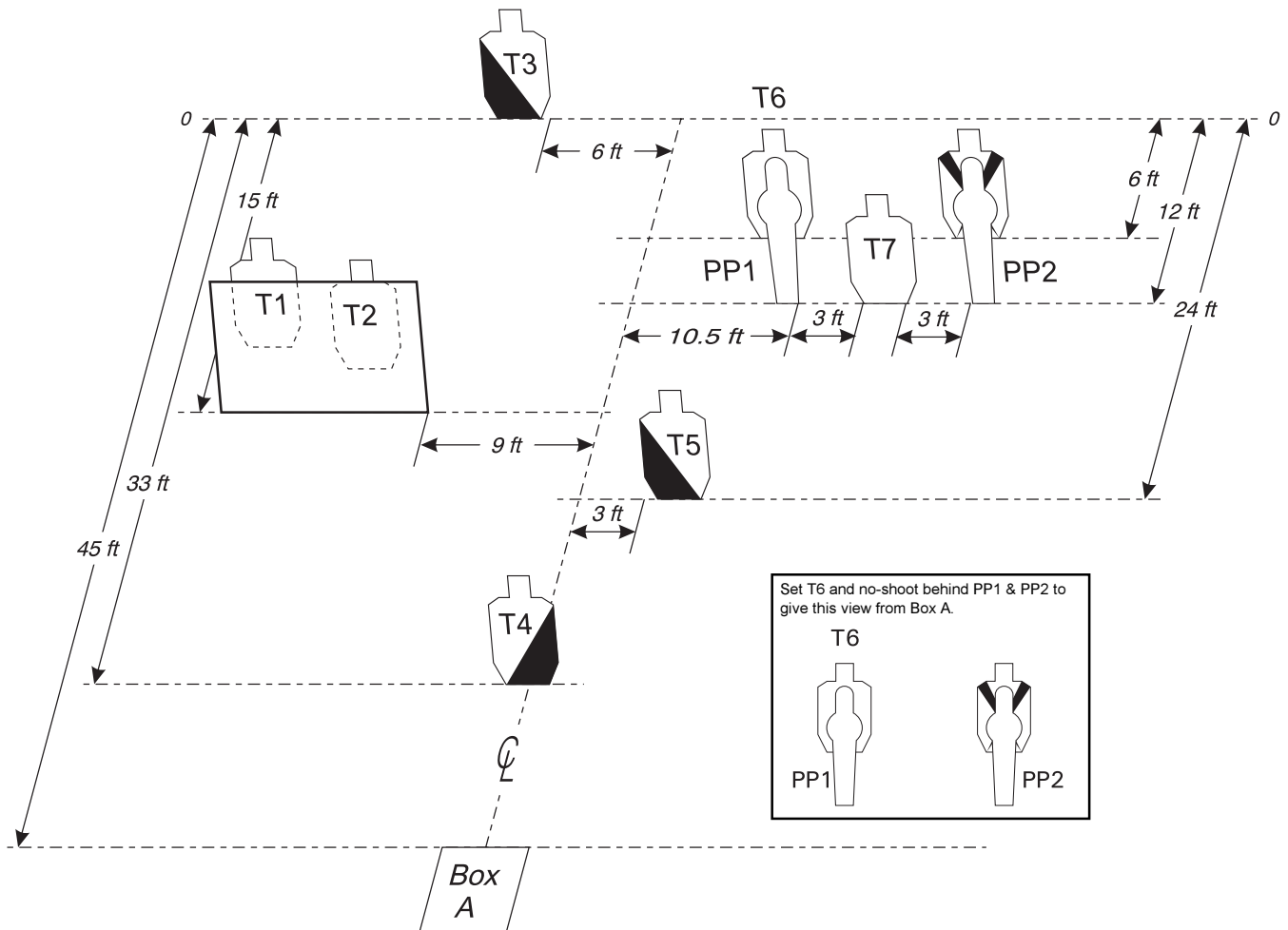
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, both arms hanging relaxed at sides.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A engage only T1-T4, then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage only T5-T7, PP1, and PP2. Competitor may engage either array first, but a reload must be done before engaging the next array. Competitor may go back to pick up misses without doing another reload after completing the initial stage requirements.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 16 rounds, 80 points
TARGETS: 7 IPSC, 2 Pepper poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
 Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set T3, T4, T5, and T7 to 5 feet high at shoulders. Set T6 and no-shoot so that top of the Pepper popper is even with the top of the A zone on T6. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Top edge of soft cover is 4 feet high. Soft cover wall is 2 feet forward of targets and



placed at the 15 foot line. Soft cover is 4 feet by 6 feet with T1 and T2 placed so that the outside edges of targets are 1 foot from their respective edges of the soft cover. T1 shows 4 inches of shoulder above soft cover. T2 has only the upper panel above soft cover.
