



**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Charles Jackson III—Mods. by US Design Team

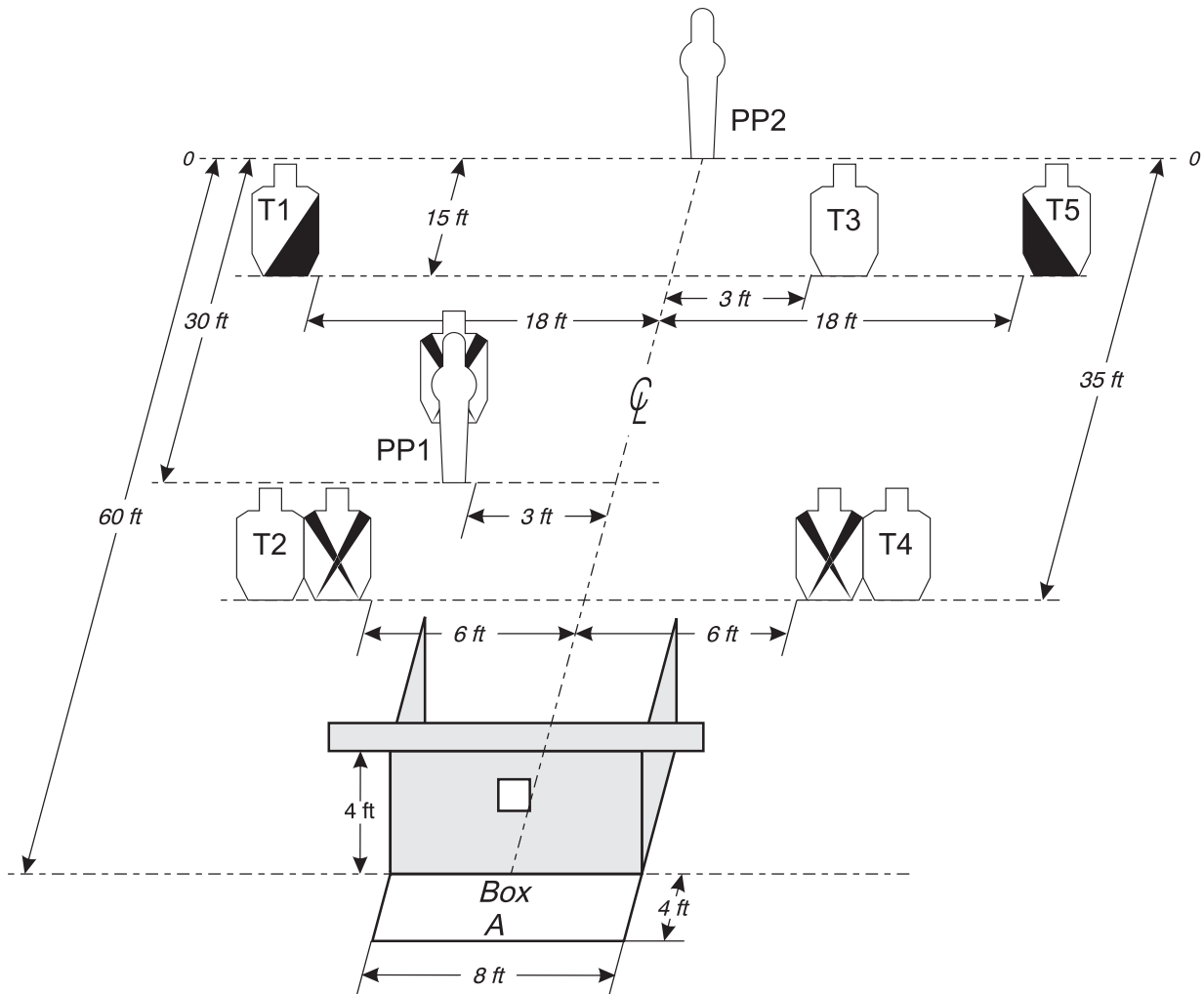
**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn, then draw and engage only T1 and T2 from under the bar on the left side of the wall, only PP1, PP2 and T3 through Port B and only T4 and T5 from under the bar on the right side of the wall. All shots must be fired while inside Box A and the three arrays may be engaged in any order.

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points  
**TARGETS:** 5 IPSC, 2 Pepper poppers  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A  
**START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



**SETUP NOTES:** Set paper targets to 4 feet high at shoulders. Place two 4-foot-long vision barriers in front of barricade so shooters see only given targets from each shooting position. T2 & T4 should be set to



overlap the non-scoring borders of targets and no-shoots. The ends of the bar on top of barricade extend 3 feet out on each side. Port B is centered in wall, and is 1 foot square. Bottom of port is 2 feet above ground.
