



**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Finger Lakes PPC. Modifications by US Design Team

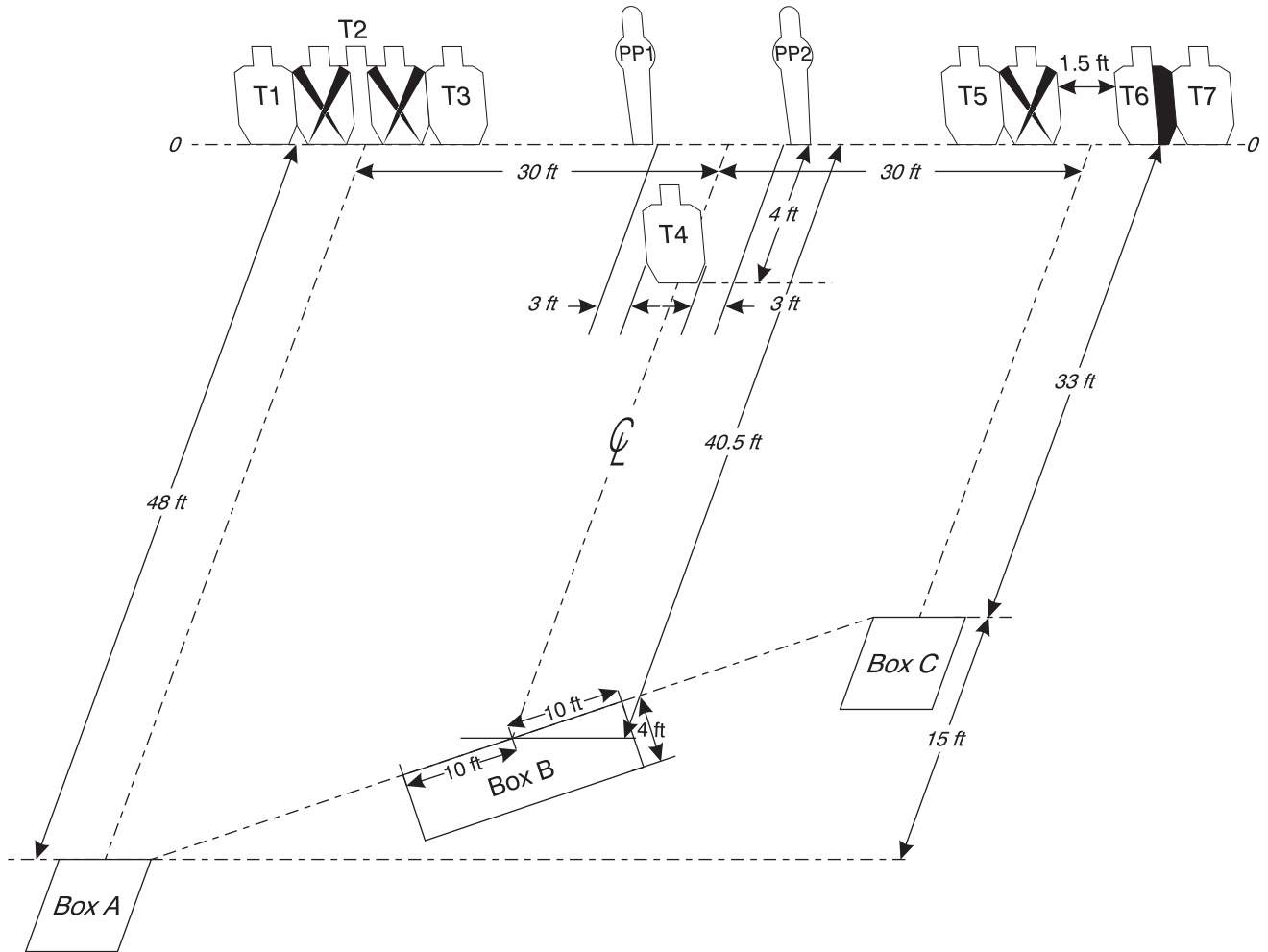
**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A back to targets, toes of both feet against rear fault line of Box A, both arms hanging relaxed at sides.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn, then draw and from Box A, engage only T1-T3. Move to Box B and from Box B, engage only T4, PP1 and PP2. Move to Box C and from Box C, engage only T5-T7. Targets engaged from Box B may be engaged while moving providing the competitor remains within the confines of Box B.

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 16 rounds, 80 points  
**TARGETS:** 7 IPSC, 2 Pepper poppers  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2/Paper, KD = 1 A  
**START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



**SETUP NOTES:** Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Edges of T1 and T3 are butted to no-shoots. The A-zone scoring lines of T2 are directly under the scoring lines of the no-shoots. Edge of T5 is butted to edge of no-shoot. T6 and T7 are butted together. Boxes



A and C are 3 feet square. Box B is 20 feet long and 4 feet wide. Place 3-foot-high rope barriers on both sides to control shooter movement. Nail a 2x2 or 2x4 to ground at both ends for fault lines.
